

# SKY-LITE 2 STAR RED AERIAL DISTRESS FLARE

For the marine recreational boating market, also land based activities such as hiking and climbing.

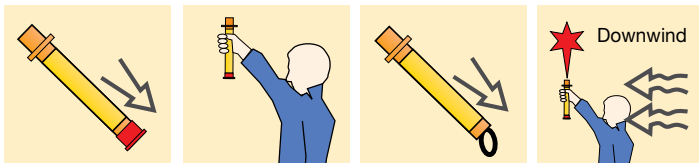
Compact, hand-held aerial flare, used to signal distress by day or night.



## Application

Use to signal distress by day or night. Two red flares are propelled to 60m (200ft) by the hand-held launcher. Medium range pyrotechnic signal flare, ideal for use on yachts, dinghies, RIBs and canoes.

## Operation



1. Hold signal firmly. Remove RED end cap. Do not point at people or property.
2. Hold vertically above head pointing away from body.
3. Hold signal firmly. Unfold firing ring and pull sharply down to fire.
4. Hold at arms length. Point Downwind.

## Storage

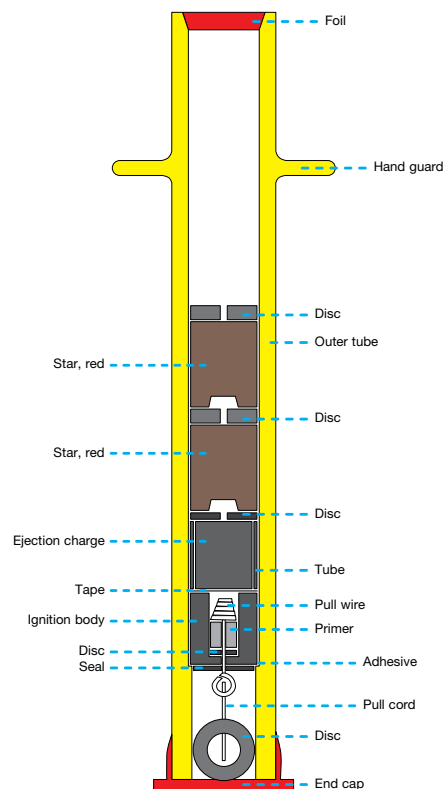
Should be stored in either the mini or large Polybottle in a dry, easily accessed location at ambient temperature.
